Take your English skills to another level. Join us for this English language learners' book club where we read aloud together and discuss the book.



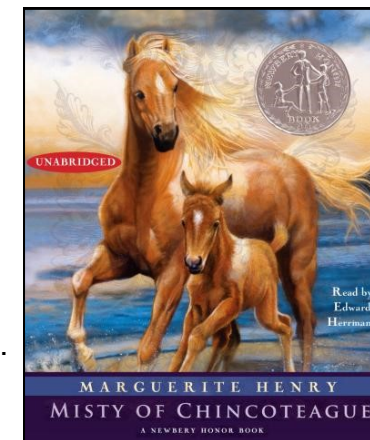

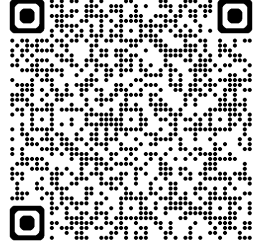
